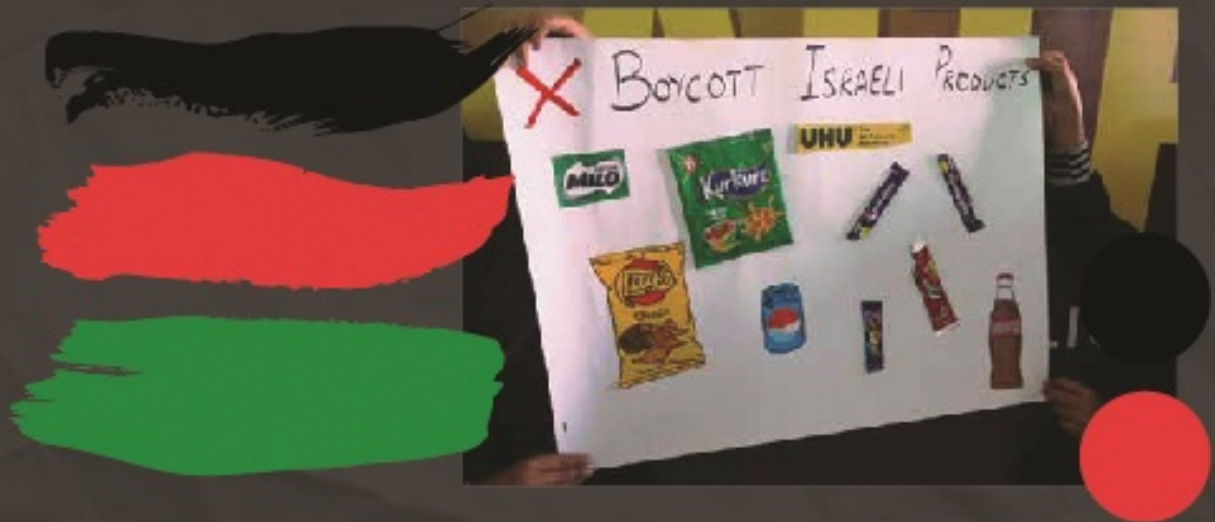

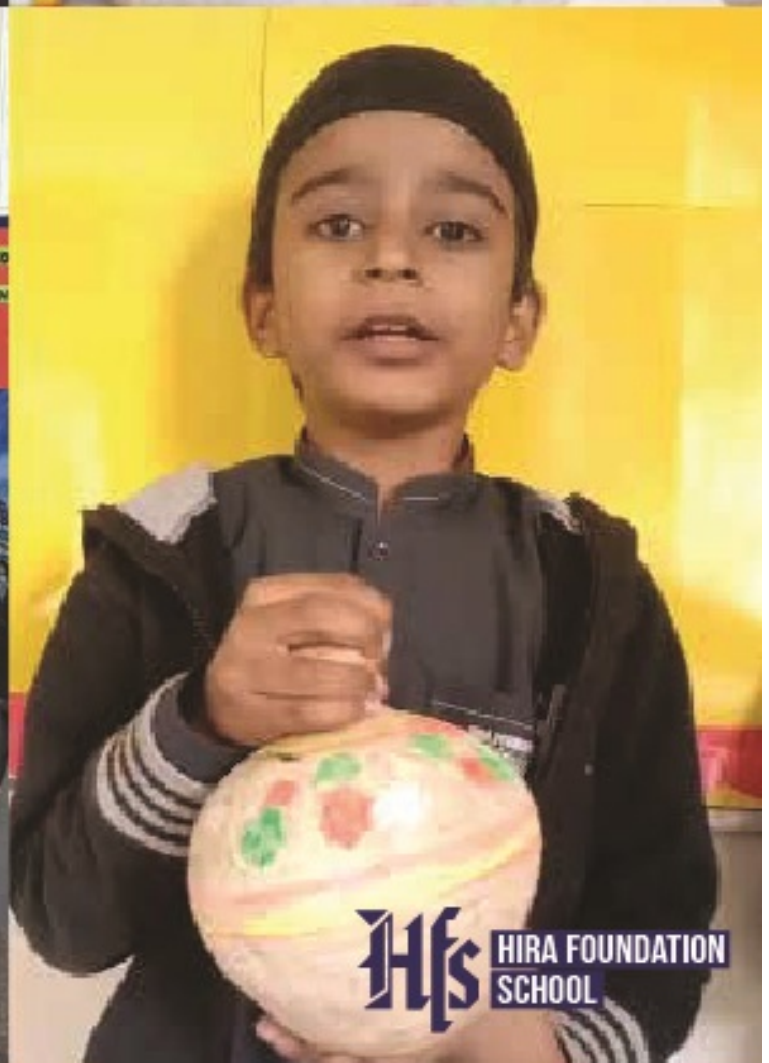

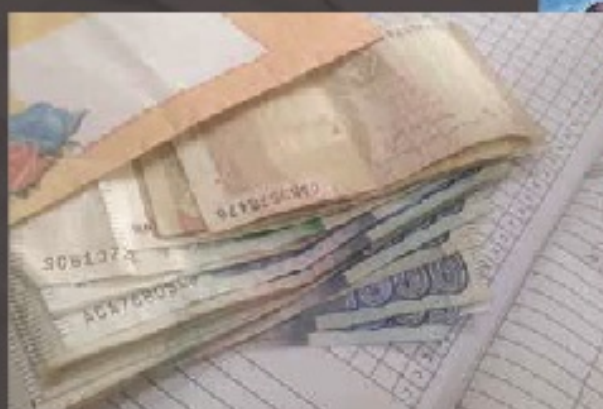
Time of Giving

Charity Campaign at Hfs Carnival

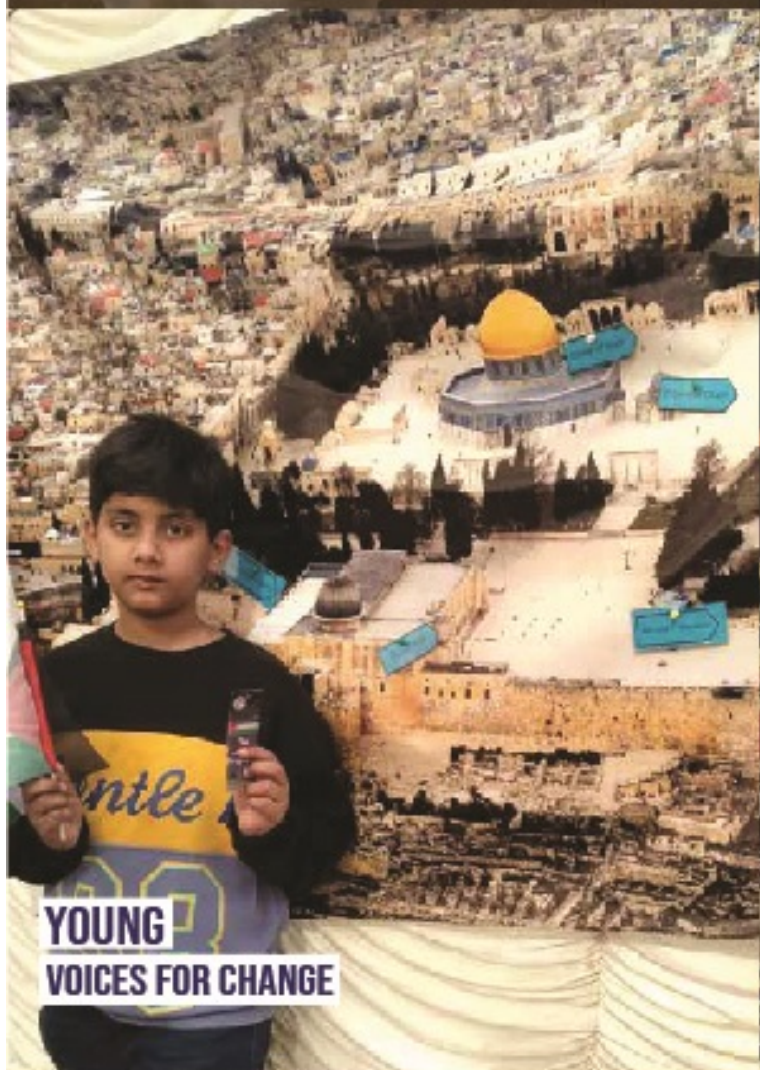

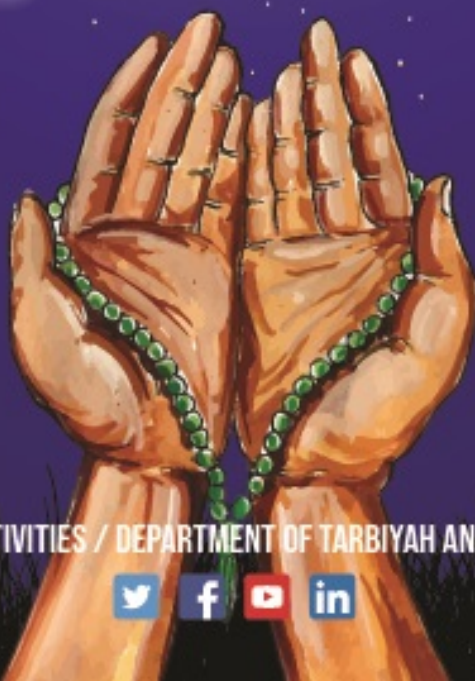


Facts About Palestine

- The Dead Sea, which is Earth's lowest natural point of elevation, is found in Palestine.
- For many centuries, olives have been a central part of Palestinian life, culture, and tradition. With over 45% of the land's area dedicated to olive trees, it is no surprise that they are a highly valued and cherished aspect of Palestine's identity.
- The majority of the population is Muslim, although there is also a large population of Christians as well.
- Palestine is known as one of the most beautiful wildernesses in the world, popping into existence throughout April and May. These include wildflowers, wild poppies, and other vibrant species of flowers which paint the colorful hillsides during its short spring season.
- There are several species of large wild animals in Palestine. These include wild mountain gazelles, Arabian oryx, desert-dwelling species of goat, wild boar, wolves, jackals, leopards, hyenas, and many types of migratory birds as well.
