Participants should maintain discipline, akhlaq (good manners), and respect throughout the event.

2. Qira'at Competition

Recitation must be with Tajweed and proper pronunciation.

3. Naat / Nasheed Recitation

Only Islamic-themed nasheeds/naats are allowed.

No shirkiya Poetry

Lyrics not matched with any song.

Time limit: 3minutes.

Participants may use cue cards but reading entire speech from paper is not allowed.

No exaggeration, mockery, or theatrical style is permitted. Time limit: 3 minutes.

Must include authentic Seerah events with reference to reliable sources.

Should clearly highlight historical accuracy (dates, places, events such as Hijrah, Battles, Travels, etc.).

2. Age Categories:

Group A: 12 – 14 years Group B: 15 – 17 years

Each school can bring one participant per category (i.e., one for Group A and one for Group B).

3. Artwork Size:

Must be made on A3 size sheet (11.7 × 16.5) only. No larger or smaller sizes will be accepted.

4. Medium:

Any art medium may be used — such as paints, poster colors, water-colors, acrylics, oil pastels, color pencils, markers, or mixed media.

5. Art Materials:

Students must bring their own art materials and A3 sheet. (No sharing of materials will be allowed.)

6. Prohibited Content:

No pictures or drawings of living beings or eyes are allowed in the artwork.
